# **Bicycle Infrastructure**

1) Bike Corral 6th & Commercial



Vancouver's first on-street bicycle corral, added on a trial basis, August 2010.

#### Dunsmuir St. Bike Lane & Viaduct



Installed in 2010 as trials, the City recently voted to make the downtown separated lanes permanent.(June 13 2012).

### 2) Great Northern Way: bike route



Separated bike route with green paving at intersections cyclists and pedestrians.

### 6) Carroll Street



Vancouver's first separated bike lane, in historic Gastown neighbourhood.

#### Seawall False Creek



A continuous, popular path around the water for both

### 7) Adanac Bikeway



The City's first and most-used bike route, it connects downtown Canucks Family Room to Burnably, and is shared wth cars. 900 cyclists per day.

## 4) Cambie St Bridge

Commerical Drive & Grandview Hwy, SE corner



Bridge has separated sidewalk on east side for cyclists & pedestrians- and great views!
