

Bike Bus Code of Conduct



Welcome to the Bike Bus! We are happy you are riding with us! To keep everyone safe and having fun, please follow these simple rules:

Stay Safe

- Listen to the Ride Leaders and Volunteers. They help keep us safe!
- Ride within the group and at a steady speed, set by the Ride Leader
- Stay in your spot and do not ride ahead of the Ride Leader.
- Stop at red lights and stop signs. Wait for the group to go together.
- Ride safely—no racing, swerving, or stopping suddenly. No riding on the sidewalks.
- Use hand signals and call out "stopping," "slowing," or "passing on your left."
- Always wear a helmet.



Be Kind and Respectful

- Be friendly to everyone.
- Listen to others and they will listen to you.
- Give people space and be careful when passing.
- No teasing, bullying, or unkind words.

Help the Group

- Be on time and check that your bike is ready to ride.
- Tell a Ride Leader if your bike has a problem or you need help.
- If you see someone who needs help, tell a Ride Leader.
- Stay with the group and follow the planned route.
- Follow the road and path rules.





Bring the Right Gear

- Make sure your bike works well (tires, brakes, chain, etc.).
- Bring a light, a bell, and clothes for the weather.
- Do not use your phone or headphones while riding.
- Hands on the handlebar all times, except when doing hand signals.

If you do not follow these rules, you may not be allowed to ride with the Bike Bus. Let's have fun and be safe together!
